

## Re-Registration

We are excited to begin our 27th year offering quality Montessori education here at Montessori Visions Academy and to celebrate the growth of our Montessori family. We are honored that you have chosen us to be your partner in educating your child. Our preferred re-registration period is through March 31, 2026 for our currently enrolled students. Enrolling early allows us to prepare for the upcoming year, so anyone re-registered by 3/31/2026 will receive a \$50 discount on the \$300 re-registration fee, paying only \$250. New families that joined our school after January 1, 2026 will pay a prorated re-registration fee of \$200 if re-registered by 3/31/2026, or \$250 after. After 3/31, we will offer any remaining positions to students on our waiting list. To re-register, please fill out and sign the financial agreement below and return it to the school with the re-registration fee. Please also let us know if you have any changes to your address, email, approved pick up list, or phone number and give us copies of any updated immunization records.

Our campuses are proud to continue to offer exceptional, quality, college preparatory Montessori education at an affordable rate for students from Infants through High School. Our curriculum will continue to develop the entire person, emphasizing a balance between the child's academic learning and social/emotional growth.

At the Sunset Campus, our Infant and Toddler rooms begin at birth through toilet-trained children and our Primary program educates students age two through five. At the Warm Springs Campus our Toddler room begins at 15 months through toilet-trained children, Primary levels are the same as Sunset, our Elementary program encompasses students from 1st to 6th grade, and the Adolescent Community program begins at 7th grade with students continuing through 12th grade. We continue to offer French and Spanish Immersion or Dual Language programs for Primary level, Spanish Dual Language for the Lower Elementary level, and French and Spanish language electives for Adolescent Community.
