Montessori AT HOME

We had a wonderful evening recently talking to families about ways to implement Montessori into their homes. We wanted to share some strategies with you to help build a school - home connection by implementing the Montessori philosophy in your home environment. We encourage parents to create an orderly, child-sized environment with accessible, open shelving for age-appropriate materials and tools. Focus on a calm, clutter-free space with natural elements to foster independence and concentration. Encourage practical life skills by providing real tools for cleaning and food preparation, and offer limited, rotating choices for activities. Help children become active participants in the care of the home by learning from watching you and through your guidance with step by step practice. Foster independence by allowing them to do things for themselves, and be a patient, observant role model. You can extend Montessori principles into the home by involving children in food preparation, encouraging nature exploration, and reading books with realistic themes. We invite all families to create a peace area in an accessible space at home where children can use the peace rose (a plastic flower) to share feelings and look for solutions to problems, as well as have peaceful activities like a zen garden or a puzzle so that they can use the space whenever they feel the need. We have attached a few articles to support you as you prepare your

Montessori home environment.
